- 1 Amending Title 34 (Game) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- Statutes, in game or wildlife protection, further providing
- for report to commission officer and for surrender of carcass
- 4 to commission officer.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Sections 2122 and 2125 of Title 34 of the
- 8 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:
- 9 § 2122. Report to commission officer.
- 10 Any person who kills any game or wildlife, other than
- 11 raccoons, under the provisions of this subchapter shall, within
- 12 24 hours, report, orally or in writing, the killing to an
- 13 officer of the commission. The report shall set forth the date,
- 14 time and place of the killing, the number of species killed
- 15 [and], the sex of the species[.] and the location of each
- 16 <u>carcass. The commission shall establish a self-reporting system</u>
- 17 that allows a person assigned to remove deer for crop damage
- 18 purposes to report each harvest to an officer of the commission
- 19 via a toll-free telephone number, online application or publicly

- 1 <u>accessible Internet website.</u>
- 2 § 2125. Surrender of carcass [to commission officer].
- 3 Except as otherwise provided in this subchapter, the entire
- 4 carcass, including the head and hide[,] of all big game animals
- 5 and the entire carcass of any other game or wildlife, other than
- 6 raccoons, less entrails, shall be made available, unless
- 7 otherwise directed by an officer of the commission, intact[,
- 8 less entrails,] to any commission officer calling for them[.] or
- 9 <u>delivered to a processor for final disposition. As used in this</u>
- 10 <u>section</u>, the term "processor" means a location specified by the
- 11 commission that is willing to accept donations of animals taken
- 12 <u>under this chapter.</u>
- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
